Awards:

All qualified participants will be awarded with a Christmas souvenir.

Idea Contents:

1. The title of the year is “Sharing Love ”
2. The origin of Christmas comes from the Good News of the Nativity Story about the birth of Jesus Christ in a manger in Bethlehem, bringing forth the forgiving love of God to every person in the world, as so written in the Bible. The teachings of the Holy Bible exhort sharing the love of Jesus with one another. Hence, the image of the Nativity Story of Jesus must be included in the design and composition of the Christmas card.
3. We may share the love of Jesus Christ and the Good News in Bible because He first loves us and comes for us. Please proclaim and present the message of love sharing. For example, sharing with your family, relatives and friends, classmates and neighbors the Good News of Jesus being born and love sharing.
4. We invite all parents to take part in the competition, share the above messages of Love with your children and convey the message of “Sharing Love” creatively and interestingly in their Christmas cards, based on 1 and 2 above.

Other Reminders:

1. Works should be presented with 2D dimensional design.
2. Student's name should be written at the back of each work.

5. Please submit your works on or before **1st November, 2022** to the class teachers.
6. Works submitted after the deadline will not be attended.
