“Vaccine Bubble” Arrangement

(Circular No. E082/2021-2022)

Dear Parents/Guardians,

The Government announced on 4th January 2022 that the implementation of “vaccine bubble” arrangement would be expanded to cover more venues from 24th February 2022 and schools would be covered in the arrangement. With reference to EDB’s letter to schools on 11th January, details on the “vaccine bubble” arrangement is as follows:

- Starting from 24th February 2022, except for those exempted, all teaching and non-teaching staff, persons providing on-campus services and visitors of kindergartens, primary and secondary schools (including special schools and the boarding sections and schools offering non-local curriculum), and private schools offering non-formal curriculum will be required to present vaccination records of at least the first dose of COVID-19 vaccine before entering the school premises. The school “vaccine bubble” arrangement is not applicable to students.

Implementation details:

| Persons permitted to enter the school premises starting from 24th February, 2022 | |
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| Teaching and non-teaching staff directly employed by the school | would only be permitted to enter the school premises by showing vaccination records of at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine, and must receive two doses of vaccine before 21 st April. |
| Persons providing on-campus services (school bus operators, tuck shop operators, nannies, volunteers) and visitors (including parents) | would only be permitted to enter the school premises by showing vaccination records of at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine. |
| Exempted personnel who have not received COVID-19 vaccine | have to provide medical certificates certifying that their health conditions are unfit for vaccination, and school staff exempted from vaccination requirement due to pregnancy are required to conduct COVID-19 tests once every three days with valid negative test results. |

- School administrative arrangements

At the latest from **24th February onwards**, all teaching and non-teaching staff, persons providing on-campus services and visitors should use the mobile application each time they enter the school premises by 24th February and thereafter (except for exempted personnel to use “LeaveHomeSafe”). Students entering the school premises can be exempted.

The school will abide by EDB’s guidelines under the instability of the pandemic situation. In case of any change in school arrangements, the school will notify parents via the school website and WhatsApp as soon as possible. For any enquiries, please contact 27293929 during school hours.
