Arrangements after Lunar New Year Holiday

(Circular No.: E084/2021-2022)

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Since the COVID-19 epidemic situation is still severe, the Education Bureau announced that all kindergartens, primary schools, secondary schools (including special schools and schools offering non-local curriculum) will extend the suspension of face-to-face classes and on-campus activities until 21st February (The school may not resume face-to-face classes before 21st February). To sustain students' learning, the school has made the following arrangements:

2. Teaching and Learning

- ✧ Google Meet will continue to be used for real-time online lessons until further notice from the EDB, please see the pink student handbook for lesson timetable. Some of the Meet ID will be updated, please see the Meet ID list for details.
- ✧ For remedial therapy lessons between 8-11/2, please refer to the same remedial therapy timetable given before the holiday. For speech therapy and occupational therapy, relevant professional staff will contact parents for arrangement updates. For career planning lessons, students will be withdrawn from Meet lessons by teachers for individual teaching.

- ✧ As time is needed for lesson change, kindly wait for teaching and professional staff to enter Google Meet. Please phone the school for any enquiries.
- ✧ Attendance will be taken during the class teacher period before lessons, please attend accordingly.
- ✧ Attendance taken during online lessons will not be shown in the report card. However, if students are absent consecutively, relevant information will be passed on to the EDB non-attendance cases team for follow up as usual.
- ✧ If the EDB announces the resumption of face-to-face classes during module 4, please bring back relevant homework and teaching materials to school for lesson use.
- ✧ Test and assessments for module 3 and the 1st school term will be changed from written tests to observation of student performance.
- ✧ ***14/2-18/2 Project learning week will be conducted online. Relevant information will be distributed between 10/2 and 11/2 together with the homework. Individual training and therapy lessons will be suspended during the project learning week.*** (Please see E087/2021-2022 circular for details)

3. School Activities

4. Others

- ✧ **Saturday workshops and PTA outings will be canceled, details on further arrangements will be released in due course, depending on the pandemic development.**
- ✧ **Life skills training camp during 23/2-25/2 will be canceled and will be conducted in alternative modes.**
- ✧ **26/2 Parent's Day will be canceled.** Class teachers will follow up on students' learning situation by phone.
- ✧ **The school will continue to keep the campus clean. The campus will be open from 8/2 onwards. Teaching staff will be on duty to look after students in need.**
- ✧ The government announced the "vaccine pass" (formerly known as "vaccine bubble") arrangement on 4th January, 2022. From 24th February, 2022 onwards, persons entering the school premises (including teaching and non-teaching personnel providing on-campus services, as well as visitors) must provide vaccination records of at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine. Students will be exempted from the arrangement (see E082/2021-2022 for details).
- ✧ In the following cases listed below, parents should contact the school nurse at 27293929 immediately to allow the school to take contingency measures and contact the Education Bureau:
 - a) the student is confirmed to contracting COVID-19 ;**
 - b) the student is considered a "close contact" of COVID-19 confirmed case patients according to the Department of Health.**
