School Special Vacation

(Circular No. E090/2021-2022)

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Due to the severity of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Chief Executive Carrie Lam has announced on 22nd February, the summer vacation in July and August will be moved early to March and April to allow for sufficient manpower and resources in fighting the pandemic. In the meantime, the school campus area may be used by the government for conducting anti-pandemic measures. School arrangement details are as follows:

1. School Administration

- **Special vacation will be held by the school from 7th March (Monday) to 20th April (Wednesday).** Upon receiving latest guidelines from the EDB, the school will notify parents of details on the resumption of class via WhatsApp, please keep track of news releases by the school.
- **If the school is used by the government as a COVID-19 testing venue, during the testing period, the school will be closed until further notice. As of today, the school has not received any notice concerning such matter.**
- **During the special vacation, unlike the time when online lessons are conducted, schools are not required to keep their campuses open. To reduce the risk of infection, parents should keep their children staying at home as far as possible during the special vacation and suspension of face-to-face classes. If individual parents, due to special circumstances, have a genuine need to send their children back to school, they should contact and liaise with the schools in advance for any possible assistance.**
- **For students who have applied for the COVID-19 vaccination at community vaccination centres led by the school, the vaccination will continue to take place at the specified date and time. Details will be sent by the school to applicants via WhatsApp.**
- **The “vaccine pass” has been in effect since 24th February, 2022. Except for exempted persons, all teaching staff, persons providing on-campus service, and visitors of the school must show vaccination records of at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine to enter the school premises. The measure will be implemented as usual during the suspension of face-to-face class and school holiday. The above “vaccine pass” arrangement is not applicable to students. Parents/guardians receiving vaccination at school, or accompanying students to receive vaccination at school, will be exempted from providing the “vaccine pass”.**

2. Teaching and Learning

- **To maintain moderate and sustainable learning over the holiday, the school has arranged the mailing of Easter holiday homework to students for revision.** Detailed lesson arrangements after special vacation and Easter holiday will be released upon further guidelines from the EDB, please continue to keep track of messages from the school and the school website. During the special vacation, there will be no online class.

5. Others

- The school will continue to implement disease prevention measures and keep the campus clean. The school will also closely abide by the “Health Prevention Measures for Schools” released by the EDB and “Health Advice to Schools for the Prevention of Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19)” by the Centre for Health Protection to prevent diseases.
- The school should remind parents to pay close attention to the physical and mental health of their children and take anti-epidemic measures during school vacation. Students should avoid going out, especially to crowded places with poor ventilation. They should maintain a balanced diet, exercise regularly, and take adequate rest to strengthen their immunity. If students are feeling unwell, they should seek medical advice promptly to receive appropriate diagnoses and treatments.
- **In the following cases listed below, please contact the school nurse at 27293929 immediately to allow the school to take contingency measures and contact the Education Bureau:**
(a) the student is confirmed to contracting COVID-19; (b) the student is considered a “close contact” of COVID-19 confirmed case patients according to the Department of Health.
