
As the special holiday will be soon coming to a close, I would like to share with you the arrangements and relevant details concerning the resumption of school starting on 21 April 2022.

Resumption of Class After Easter Holiday (Circular No.: E091/2021-2022)

Dear Parents and Guardians,

In view of the latest development of the COVID-19 pandemic, the EDB announced the gradual resumption of class. After careful consideration, the school has made the following class arrangements for resumption of class after Easter holiday. Details are as follows:

Teaching and Learning :

- On the first day of face-to-face class (Secondary section: 21/4, primary section: 28/4), kindly return all homework, worksheet, unused visual arts material, and other materials (if any) to school.
- Online class timetable for primary section will be the same as before the special holiday, arrangements for therapy lessons will be confirmed later.
- As both face-to-face and online class will be conducted at the same time during the first week of class, please be patient and allow time for teachers to interchange between lessons.

School Bus arrangements :

- The school bus service company will notify parents of the bus arrangements before the resumption of class. For any related enquiries, please contact bus nannies.

Administration :

1. The school will continue to implement disease prevention measures and keep the campus clean. The school will also closely abide by the “Health Prevention Measures for Schools” released by the EDB and “Health Advice to Schools for the Prevention of Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19)” by the Centre for Health Protection to prevent diseases.

2. With reference to the EDB's guidelines, kindly note the following:

2.1 After class resumption, if parents confirm to come across any of the following cases, students **are not** allowed to return to school. Please contact the **school nurse** immediately at 27293929 for the school to take immediate action and notify the EDB.

- (a) the student is confirmed to contracting COVID-19 ;
- (b) the student is considered a “close contact” of a COVID-19 a positive/preliminary positive case and is awaiting COVID-19 test results.
- (c) the student is a household member of a “close contact” and is awaiting COVID-19 test results.
- (d) the student is subject to compulsory testing according to the “Prevention and Control of Disease (Compulsory Testing for Certain Persons) Regulation” and is awaiting test results.

Students who are subject to compulsory COVID-19 testing should note the following:

* As advised by the government, please undergo COVID-19 testing within the specified period as soon as possible. Please contact the school by phone **after receiving negative test result confirmation** and present **documents of proof*** (e.g. mobile text message, test result report). Only return to school after the school has confirmed the reception of relevant documents. **Those who return to school against regulations will be denied from entering the school premises.**

***How to present document of proof:**

1. Scan the QR code on the right to access a Google Form and upload respective documents of proof (e.g. mobile text messages, test result reports). Website link access to this form will also be sent to parents via WhatsApp



OR

2. Visit the school in person to present documents of proof (please notify the school beforehand by phone)

2.2.1 Every student has to complete a Rapid-Antigen Test (RAT) and fill in a health declaration form every day before returning to school. RATs should be conducted in the morning and only students obtaining negative results are allowed to return to school for lessons. Students tested positive **must not return to school**. Students should stay at home and parents should inform the school the school and report to the Department of Health as soon as possible within 24 hours via the “**Declaration System for individuals tested positive for COVID-19 using Rapid Antigen Test**”.

2.2.2 For students tested positive, parents should submit students' negative COVID-19 test result before returning to school. (For submission methods, please see *2.1)

2.2.3 For those recovered from COVID-19, they are not required to be tested within three months from the date of the recovery (except for those with symptoms). For more information, please see the following website and video.

2.3 On the first day of face-to-face class after the holiday, parents have to state the following information in the pink student handbook for the school's inspection.

(Secondary section) 「 I have conducted the Rapid Antigen Test on 21st April morning, and the result of the test is negative.

(Primary section) 「 I have conducted the Rapid Antigen Test on 28th April morning, and the result of the test is negative.

*On the first day of face-to-face class, class teachers will paste a health declaration form on the inner cover page of the pink handbook. Please take student's **body temperature and conduct the RAT at home** before returning to school.(Appendix 1) If students have fever or other respiratory infection symptoms, please **do not** go to school and seek medical attention immediately.

- 2.4 **If students are unable to show proof of completing the RAT, they are not allowed to go to class. The school will immediately ask parents to fetch respective students.**
 - 2.5 **The “vaccine pass” has been in effect since 24th February, 2022. Except for exempted persons, all teaching staff, persons providing on-campus service, and visitors of the school must show vaccination records of at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine to enter the school premises. The above “vaccine pass” arrangement is not applicable to students.**
3. During online class, the campus will remain open to provide assistance and answer parents' queries.

The school will continue keep track of latest releases from the Education Bureau and the Department of Health, and will notify parents via the school website and WhatsApp. For any enquiries, please contact the school at 27293929.

Appendix 1

1. Parents/Guardians should take students' body temperature every day before going to school. For the range of normal body temperature, please refer to "the Guidance Note on Monitoring Body Temperature" published by the Centre for Health Protection. (see https://www.chp.gov.hk/files/pdf/guidance_note_on_monitoring_of_body_temperature.pdf)
If students experience fever, they must not return to school. Kindly seek medical attention immediately, notify the school, and rest at home.
2. Parents/Guardians should sign the declaration form after taking student's body temperature and conducting the RAT. Students should bring to form to school and allow teaching staff/class teachers to check the form.
