**Latest Anti-Epidemic Arrangement** (Circular No.: E143/2022-2023)

Dear Parents/Guardians,

As the epidemic has been stabilized, the EDB announced the cancellation of student rapid antigen test (RAT) and body temperature record arrangement on 16<sup>th</sup> March. The current and latest anti-epidemic arrangements for school the will be implemented and in effort on 17<sup>th</sup> April, details are as follows:

- Starting from 15<sup>th</sup> March, 2023, students of primary schools, kindergartens and secondary schools are no longer required to ergo daily RAT before going to school.
- Anti-epidemic plastic shields will be removed from students' desks.
- Students are no longer required to take body temperature before school every day. Parents are not required to fill in and sign the health declaration form every school day. Body temperature will be taken at school via the infrared thermometer every day before entering classrooms.
- The mask-wearing requirement was lifted by the government on 1<sup>st</sup> March, 2023. Mask-wearing is not required for school teaching staff, students or school visitors. Parents may decide according to individual needs, if mask-wearing is necessary for your child. Parents are recommended to provide **two** spare masks for students.
- If students are tested positive for COVID-19, parents must inform the school nurse. Students tested positive must take sick leave and **are not allowed to attend class at school** until a negative RAT result is obtained and students show no COVID-19 symptoms.

**Please remind your child to wash hands regularly and wear a mask appropriately to prevent the spread of disease. Kindly note the following disease prevention measures:**

- If students have a fever, they should not go to school until two days after the fever has been recovered.
- If students experience coughing, sore throat and other upper respiratory tract infection symptoms, they should wear a mask and seek medical assistance as soon as possible, and should only return to school when fully recovered.
- Limited spare masks will be provided by the school. Kindly prepare sufficient masks for parents to avoid the spread of disease.
